SISTER HELEN DEL CARPINE, MPF

The Religious Teachers Filippini mourn the passing of Sr. Helen Del Carpine, 93, who died June 24, 2018, at St. Joseph Hall, Morristown, NJ.

Viewing will be held on Wednesday, June 27, 2018, from 10:00 - 12:00 noon at the St. Lucy Chapel, Villa Walsh, Morristown, NJ, followed by a Mass of Christian Burial celebrated at 12 noon by Rev. Anthony Sirianni, Pastor at St. Helena's, Edson, NJ. Interment will take place following the liturgy at Ave Maria Cemetery. Arrangements are by the Doyle Funeral Home, Morristown, NJ.

Born and raised in N. Y. City, Sister Helen entered the Religious Teachers Filippini on July 7, 1940. She received her religious habit on June 15, 1941, and made her final religious profession on August 27, 1944. Sister Helen was awarded a BS degree in Elementary Education from Georgian Court University.

For more than 45 years Sr. Helen taught in the elementary grades, in the Archdioceses of Newark, NJ, New York, NY, Phila.,PA; and in the Dioceses of Scranton, PA, Brooklyn, NY, Cleveland, OH, Baltimore, MD, Trenton, NJ, Camden, NJ, and Ogdensburg, NY. Sister Helen also taught religion classes after school wherever she was missioned. She possessed a very generous and giving spirit and offered service wherever help was needed. Because she was gifted with culinary gifts and great strength, she volunteered and utilized these talents at the Motherhouse, Villa Walsh, through many hot summers. Others knowing these assets and combined with a spirit of generosity and a great sense of humor, she was often called upon to be of assistance.

Sister Helen spent her last years in active retirement at Holy Family Convent, Nutley NJ. After spending one year (2010) at Our Lady Queen of Peace, Maywood, NJ, she entered St. Joseph Hall at Villa Walsh in 2011. During these 7 years, her acceptance of illness and limitations were admired by those who cared for her.

Sister Helen is the last of twelve siblings. She is predeceased by her parents Cosmo and Louise (Yezzo) Del Carpine; brothers: Anthony, Dominick, Cosmo, John Del Carpine; sisters Antoinette Del Carpine, Anna Boiano, Mary Sisti, Angelina Borelli, Carmela Benevento, Sister Louise Del Carpine, MPF, Teresa Perrino. She is survived by many loving nieces and nephews.
